How to conduct Live and VIRTUAL Theraplay® Sessions and The Marschak Interaction Method Assessment (MIM) are combined in this one month ONLINE training.

This course is presented through the Canadian learning platform Thinkific.com as well as through Zoom for video conference classes.

Each week includes viewing an independent webinar which consists of viewing slides with audio descriptions, video samples of topics and client sessions.

Components covered will include the following topics and provide 28 Unit hours of learning and will take place across 4 weeks

CEU certificates of completion will be provided for the workshop component of online course is completed. Foundational Theraplay Certification certificates will be provided once all components of Foundational level are fulfilled.

Theraplay® is a short-term, structured therapy which focuses on enhancing attachments. It promotes self-esteem, language skills, behavioural skills, social skills as well as enhances relationships between significant others. Theraplay can be used with a single child, an entire family or with groups of children. Professionals around the world have been trained in Theraplay and are using Theraplay in a wide variety of settings and populations, including: Attachment therapy for foster/adopted children, Therapy for trauma and abuse victims, Therapy for children with behavioral and developmental problems. www.theraplaycanada.ca for more information <https://theraplaycanada.ca/what-is-theraplay/>

The Marschak Interaction Method Assessment (MIM) is a structured technique for observing and assessing the relationship between two individuals, for example, biological parent and child, foster or adoptive parent and child, supportive caregiver and child. It consists of a series of simple tasks designed to elicit a range of behaviours in four dimensions.

Learning objectives of this course include

- Understanding of the history and theory of Theraplay®;
- Increased knowledge on the interactional basis of parent-infant attachment and self-esteem
- Skill development and use of the four Theraplay® dimensions;
 - Knowledge of how Theraplay® is used to meet the needs of children with behavior problems, foster and adopted children, autistic children, adolescents, and traumatized children;
- Knowledge of how parents are guided to empathically observe and participate in Theraplay® sessions aimed at fostering better parent-child attachment.
- Knowledge of how to administer the MIM including methods of recording non-verbal and verbal behaviors, making inferences and formulating hypotheses;
- Knowledge of how an MIM report is organized;
- Knowledge of how a feedback session is conducted;
- Knowledge of how the MIM is used as a guideline for planning treatment.

Theraplay[®] training workshops are intensive, active and rewarding. The number of participants is limited so that each person can receive the special attention that makes for a good training experience. There are opportunities to:

- Observe video treatment of client(s) including the assessment via the Marschak Interaction Method, feedback to the parents, and Theraplay[®] sessions (done live and virtually)
- Watch video of treatment with a variety of clients
- Practice the use of Theraplay[®] techniques for live and virtual sessions
- Plan how each participant can use Theraplay[®] with their own clients

Theraplay Certification Practicum Information for those interested in signing up for Full Package:

To recognize significant milestones of those in the practicum, the practicum is divided into three levels: Foundational Theraplay Practitioner, Intermediate Theraplay Practitioner and Certified Theraplay Practitioner. Only training and supervision provided by Certified Theraplay Trainers and Certified Theraplay Supervisors will be credited toward certification at any of the three levels.

The following registration requirements will be required if choosing Full Package option for this training:

Written Materials (electronic versions acceptable)

- Description of your professional experience, i.e. a curriculum vita or resume
- Signed copy of practicum attestation form
- Copy of your current professional license, or your college/university transcript in countries that do not license
- Written permission from your supervisor or agency director (if applicable)
- Written consent from the families whose sessions are being submitted for supervision
- Confirmation of professional malpractice insurance, if required in your country

Foundational Theraplay Practitioner Information

Total # of Individual Supervised Sessions = 8

Total # of Unsupervised Sessions = 32

- Submit eight sessions of Theraplay treatment for supervision accompanied by the *Session Supervision Form*. These sessions should be of **two different clients** and should include at least one MIM and one parent feedback session or parent session. For the eighth session, submit the *Session Supervision Form*, completed by yourself and the *Theraplay Practitioner Foundational Certificate Registration: 8th Session Self-Description by Dimension Form* rating the **totality** of your work.
- Candidates must be rated an average of 3 or higher and recommended by their supervisor. Please see *Evaluating Competency* for information about non-passing evaluations.
- Complete a total of 32 *unsupervised* Theraplay sessions and submit a log for your file.
